


How to do a Write-In on a Paper Ballot

To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, locate the office you wish to write-in the candidates name for, go to the bottom of that column, print the name clearly in the box labeled 'write-in', staying within the box.

No write-in shall be voted for any person for any office whose name appears on the ballot as a nominated or designated candidate for the office or position in question; any write-in, so voted shall not be counted.

A write-in must be cast in its appropriate place on the ballot, or it shall be void and not counted.
