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Steuben County Announces County Offices Open to Walk-Ins

In conjunction with New York State's removal of most restrictions on businesses and organizations in response to COVID-19 and the reopening of State Courts, Steuben County will reopen all offices to public walk-in, beginning Monday, May 24th.

In accordance with CDC and NYSDOH guidance, individuals who are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 do not need to wear face coverings, unless their visit is to State Court offices, as that organization still requires face coverings for all. Individuals who are not fully vaccinated for COVID-19 must wear face coverings in all public areas of County office buildings, such as hallways and office suites.

In addition, we have been notified that DMV can also open for walk-ins, which to this point have been prohibited by executive order of the Governor. DMV appointments will be honored through June 14, 2021. It is necessary that you have all required documentation upon arrival, and it will be beneficial to have all required forms completed. Forms are available at dmv.ny.gov and will also be available at the entrance of the Main County Office Building as well as the Corning and Hornell DMV offices. At this time, all offices continue to process transactions for Steuben County residents, Steuben County land owners and contiguous counties only.

"We are grateful for the patience of Steuben County residents and the flexibility and hard work of County staff," said County Manager Jack Wheeler. "While all offices have been fully functional and providing services to residents utilizing appointments, we are pleased to reopen the facilities to walk-in visits."
