DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

This position assists the Director of Information Technology in the overall operation of the department. It is a highly technical administrative and supervisory position involving the responsibility for directing the interfacing of systems software and hardware for the effective operation of county government. Duties include supervision of the system analysts, network administrators, programmers, help desk staff, and PC coordinators. This position requires the deputy to assign proper staff to resolve difficult technical problems and perform standard day to day operations. The incumbent works on active department projects as requested by various County departments. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Director of Information Technology with wide latitude permitted for the exercise of independent judgment. The Deputy works for and in the place of the Director of Information Technology. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and either:

- (a) Graduation from a regionally-accredited or New York State-registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree and four years of full-time or equivalent part-time satisfactory, paid experience in electronics information technology operations, at least one year of which must have been in a supervisory position in computer programming, networking, or systems design; or
- (b) Graduation from a regionally-accredited or New York State-registered college or university with an Associate's Degree in Applied Science in information technology or a closely-related field and six years of full-time or equivalent part-time satisfactory, paid experience in electronic information technology, at least one year of which must have been in a supervisory position in computer programming, networking, or systems design; or
- (c) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (a) and (b) above.
