GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Objective:**

(R042208)

This bid document is published in order to obtain competitive prices for: **Cleaning, Washing and Sealing of Steuben County Bridges.**

2. **Acquisition of Bid Documents:**

(R042208)

- a. Bid documents are available, as of this date, at the Steuben County Purchasing Department, 3 East Pulteney Square, Bath, New York. The office is open Monday – Friday, 8:30 A.M. – 4:30 P.M., except holidays. Telephone number 607-664-2484. These documents are also available on the internet; Steuben County website at www.steubencony.org.
- b. Each bidder bears sole responsibility for acquisition of bid documents. Request for bid documents to be forwarded is neither a guarantee nor an incurred obligation on the part of Steuben County to ensure requestor's receipt of bid documents; timely or otherwise.
- c. Receipt of these bid documents, unsolicited or otherwise, shall not be construed a pre-determination of your company's qualifications to receive a contract award. Nor shall said receipt of these bid documents be interpreted an endorsement that the recipient's equipment, materials, products, and/or services are in compliance with the bid specifications.

3. **Document Number:**

- b. Relevant award(s), contract(s), agreement(s), correspondence, etc. shall reference the assigned document number.
- c. It shall be understood by all interested parties that unless amended by, and only to the extent amended by, the Commissioner of Public Works or the Director of Purchasing, this document (as well as all requirements set forth herein) shall become an integral component of any and all relevant contract(s)/purchase order(s)/agreement(s).

4. **Examination, Interpretation, Correction of Bid Documents:**

(R042208)

Each bidder shall examine all bid documents and judge all matters relating to the adequacy and accuracy of such documents. Any inquiries, suggestions or requests concerning interpretation, clarification or additional information pertaining to this bid solicitation shall be in writing and submitted to the Purchasing Department prior to the scheduled bid opening. The County shall not be responsible for oral interpretations given by any county employee, representative or others. The issuance of written addendum/addenda is the only official method whereby interpretation, clarification or additional information can be given.

5. **Requirements:**

(R051908)

a. **Prevailing Law -**

To all interested parties – any and all requirements specified herein notwithstanding, it is Steuben County's intent that, in all instances and under any circumstance, the law of the land shall be in force. Steuben County does not knowingly request nor does it knowingly authorize action(s) which are contrary to the laws, regulations, mandates and all such statutes which are in force at any time during the term of any contract awarded as a result of this bid solicitation. Laws, regulations, mandates and all such statutes as promulgated by authorized government entities shall prevail.

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b. **Requirements –**

It shall be understood and agreed by all interested parties that, unless amended (specifications modified and/or waived) by Steuben County, and only to the extent amended by the County, any and all information contained in this bid document is to be considered an essential component of the bid document and subsequent contract(s) **AND** that the bid document as published or amended represents the requirements acceptable to Steuben County.

However, any and all requirements specified herein notwithstanding, it shall be understood and agreed by all interested parties that the following shall apply:

Steuben County reserves as its right, the right to amend (modify and/or waive) specifications where such amendment;

- i. does not alter the essential nature and/or performance (the form, function, and utility) of the equipment, product, or service.
 - ii. encourages the proffer of equivalent equipment, product, or service from interested vendors and manufacturers.
- c. Unless amended (specifications modified and/or waived) by the County, and only to the extent amended by the County, this document (all information, terms and conditions, requirements, specifications, and addendum/addenda) shall prevail. If amended, said document as amended shall prevail.
- i. Award of a bid shall not be construed as approval, by the County, for the awardee to deviate from this document; regardless of whether said deviation(s) is stated in the bidder's attachment(s) to its bid.
 - ii. Further, the County shall not be bound by the contents and language expressed in the bidder's bid attachment(s) to its bid; including any attachment(s) submitted to the bidder by manufacturers, sub-contractors, suppliers, and other parties.

6. **Preparation of Bid Documents:**

(R042208)

Bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents and prepared in the following manner:

- a. All bid forms shall be legibly completed using a permanent medium (e.g. ink, typewriter, laser printer, etc.).
 - i. If the submittal of unit price(s) is a requirement, said *unit price(s) shall prevail*.
 - ii. *All mathematical functions (extensions, additions, etc.) are subject to audit.*
 - iii. In the event of a discrepancy between the price in words and that in figures, the lower price shall be considered the price bid.
 - iv. Each price bid shall be expressed as a numerical dollar value; indicators such as ditto marks, arrows, etc. are not acceptable.
- b. All forms requiring the bidder's signature shall be signed by the bidder or the bidder's authorized representative. Erasures and/or alterations shall be initialed by the individual whose signature appears on the bid forms.
- c. The bidder shall submit the bid in accordance with the bid documents and shall not make any changes in the wording of the bid forms or make any stipulations or qualify the bid in any manner.
- d. Unless otherwise specified by Steuben County, all bids are required to be: **FOB Destination, freight allowed. Destination to be designated by the County.**
- e. All bids shall be firm for a period of forty-five (45) days from the bid opening date; during which time the County shall render its decision.

7. **Non-Collusive Bidding Clause and Certificate:**

(R041811)

- a. Clause –

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“By submission of this bid, each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid, each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of knowledge and belief:

1. The prices in this bid have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other bidder or with any competitor;
2. Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the bidder and will not knowingly be disclosed by the bidder prior to opening, directly or indirectly, to any other bidder or to any competitor; and
3. No attempt has been made or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.”

- b. The bidder shall submit a signed and dated Non-Collusive Bidding Certificate with its bid. Said certificate is mandated by Section 103-d of the General Municipal Law. Reference the “**NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING CERTIFICATE**” form included in this bid document.

8. **Hold Harmless Clause and Form:**

(R041811)

- a. Clause –

“**HOLD HARMLESS.** The Agent shall at all times defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County of Steuben and its employees from any and all claims, damages or judgments or for the defense or payment thereof, based on any claim, action or cause of action whatsoever, including any action for libel, slander, or personal injury, or any affiliated claims, by reason of any act or failure to properly act on the part of Agent and in particular as may arise from the performance under this contract. Such obligation to the County shall not be construed to negate, abridge or reduce other rights of indemnity which would otherwise exist. This provision shall supersede any other provision in this Agreement deemed to be in conflict, unless specifically stated otherwise. In the event of an injury by the subcontractor or its employees, they shall cause notice to be served upon the County within twenty-four (24) hours of any such injury.”

- b. The bidder shall submit a signed and dated Hold Harmless Clause form with its bid. Reference the “**HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE**” form included in this bid document.

9. **Iranian Energy Sector Divestment Certification:**

(05/31/12)

Contractor/proposer hereby represents that said contractor/proposer is in compliance with New York State General Municipal Law Section 103-g entitled “Iranian Energy Sector Divestment”.

- a. By submission of this bid, each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder certifies and in the case of a joint bid, each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief, that each bidder is not on the list created pursuant to NYS Finance Law Section 165-a(3)(b).
- b. The bidder shall submit a signed, notarized and dated Iranian Energy Sector Divestment Certification with its bid.

Said certificate is mandated by Section 103-g of the General Municipal Law. Reference the Iranian Energy Sector Divestment Certificate form included in this bid document.

10. **Required Insurance(s) and OSHA Training:**

(R041811)

- a. This bid document includes an information sheet entitled: **STEUBEN COUNTY STANDARD INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS AND CERTIFICATE OF NYS WORKER’S**

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- COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE.** These requirements establish the minimum insurance(s) which the awardee(s) shall have in effect prior to entering into a contract to do business with Steuben County. Said insurance(s) are required to remain in effect throughout the term of the contract(s). In the event that the awardee's insurance lapses during the term of the contract, the County reserves, as its right, the right to cancel the awardee's contract(s) and to purchase the contracted product(s)/service(s) on the open market; with any increase in cost(s) to Steuben County being charged to the awardee. Credit shall not be issued to the awardee where open market cost(s) to the County are less than the cost(s) contracted with the awardee.
- b. **Additional Insured, Certificate Holder, and Bid Document Number -**
- i. **Steuben County shall be named* as an "Additional Insured"** in the contractor's policy for all intents and purposes of contract(s) issued as a result of an award of this bid. ***Note: "Additional Insured"** shall read – **Steuben County**, 3 East Pulteney Square, Bath, NY 14810; reference **9.b.iii**, herein.
 - ii. **"Certificate Holder"** shall read – **Steuben County**, 3 East Pulteney Square, Bath, NY 14810; reference **9.b.iii**, herein.
 - iii. With regard to **"Additional Insured"** and **"Certificate Holder"**; unless specified to the contrary herein, the following shall **not** be acceptable to Steuben County:
 - Other designations such as "Steuben County Legislature"
 - Specific departments (committees, sub-groups, etc.) such as "Department of Public Works"
 - Other entities (public or private) and named individuals such as "ABC" Township, "XYZ" Corporation, "John and Mary Doe", etc.
 - iv. The **Bid Document Number and the Bid Title** shall be referenced in the "Description..." / "Additional Comments" section of the Certificate of Insurance form.
- c. Each awardee shall submit an **original** of its **Certificate of Insurance and NYS Worker's Compensation Insurance Coverage form** (which indicates the contractor's compliance with the above sections a. and b.) to the following: Steuben County Department of Public Works, Attention: Debra Mess, Senior Acct. Clerk Typist, 3 East Pulteney Square, Bath, New York 14810 (607) 664-2460.
- d. The **Certificate of Insurance and NYS Worker's Compensation Insurance Coverage form** must be approved by the County Risk Manager prior to the contractor's acting on and/or performing any of the obligations it incurred as a result of the award and/or contract.
- e. Self-employed persons must carry such Worker's Compensation coverage as directed by the Steuben County Risk Manager.
- f. **Workers' Compensation Insurance Exemption—**
Contractors claiming to be exempt from the requirement to carry/provide Workers' Compensation Insurance shall submit a fully executed CE-200 form; the form to be complete, notarized, and stamped as received by the New York State Workers' Compensation Board.
- g. **OSHA Training—**
Wherein a contractor and Steuben County are both parties to a contract involving a public works project with an aggregate dollar value of **two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00 or more)**; said contract shall be understood, by all parties, to include "the provisions that all of the contractor's and sub contractors laborers, workers, and mechanics shall be certified as having successfully completed a ten (10) hour OSHA approved course in construction safety and health." Such requirement having been mandated by the New York State Laws of 2007, chapter 282. In those instances where a Bid/RFP submittal is required, said certification(s) shall be included with the bidder's/proposer's submittal. The contractor shall not allow participation in the contracted work by its non-certified staff; i.e. all of the contractor's non-certified laborers, workers, and mechanics.

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11. **Sales Tax Exemption:**

(R040809)

The County is exempt from payment of sales and compensating use taxes of the State of New York and of cities and counties within the State of New York.

12. **NYS Labor Law; “Prevailing Wage and Supplements”:**

(R121208)

- a. The attention of each and all bidders is directed to Articles 8 and 9 of the New York State Labor Law in general, but also specifically with regard to – **“Prevailing Wage and Supplements”**. Steuben County does, in good faith, identify those projects/services it believes to be – “Prevailing Wage and Supplements” projects/services. The failure of Steuben County to accurately assess the wage status of a particular project/service shall not relieve the awardee of its responsibility to perform in accordance with the above referenced articles. Interested parties are directed to contact the NYS Department of Labor, Binghamton District Office at (607) 721-8005 for a determination of project/service status.
- b. All interested parties (including, but not limited to, bidders, contractors, and sub-contractors) shall note, understand and comply with the following:
In the event the New York State Department of Labor amends the “Prevailing Wage Rate Schedule” applicable to contracts entered into as a result of an award of this bid solicitation document, said interested party(ies) that are required to pay “Prevailing Wages and Supplements” shall be required to pay said “Prevailing Wages and Supplements” in accordance with the most current, applicable **“Prevailing Wage Rate Schedule”** in effect at the time the work is performed.
- c. **The General Provisions of Laws Covering Workers; NYS-DOL** requires as follows:
“Every contractor and subcontractor shall submit to the Department of Jurisdiction (i.e. Steuben County), within thirty (30) days after issuance of its first payroll and every thirty (30) days thereafter, a transcript of the original payrolls, subscribed and affirmed as true under penalty of perjury. The Department of Jurisdiction (i.e. Steuben County) shall receive and maintain such payrolls.” As provided for, by the above referenced provisions, Steuben County is authorized to withhold payment(s) to contractors who are not in compliance with all NYS Department of Labor Law(s); with specific attention to Articles 8 and 9. **Therefore, Steuben County shall withhold payment(s) to contractors who have not submitted the initial “Certified Payroll” and the periodic “Certified Payroll(s)” as required herein.**

13. **Wicks Law Projects under \$500,000.**

(041811)

Pursuant to Section 101 of the General Municipal Law, bidders on a public works contract, where the preparation of separate specifications is not required, shall submit with its bid a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting, (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilation and air conditioning apparatus and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures. After the low bid is announced, the sealed list of subcontractors submitted with such low bid shall be opened and the names of such subcontractors shall be announced, and thereafter any change of subcontractor or agreed-upon amount to be paid to each shall require the approval of the public owner, upon showing presented to the public owner of legitimate construction need for such change, which shall be open to public inspection. Legitimate construction need shall include, but not to be limited to, a change in project specifications, a change in construction material costs, a change to subcontractor status as determined pursuant to paragraph (e) of subdivision two of section two hundred twenty-two of the labor law, or the subcontractor has become otherwise unwilling, unable or unavailable to perform the subcontract. The

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sealed lists of subcontractors submitted by all other bidders shall be returned to them unopened after the contract award.

14. **Equivalents:**

(R042208)

Where, in the bid documents, one certain kind, type, brand, technology or product manufacturer is named, it shall be regarded as the required standard of quality. It is not meant to exclude competition in any way. Similar equipment, products, or service, which are equal in quality, performance, compatibility and equally adaptable for the intended purposes, as determined by the County, and are submitted as specified in the bid documents, will be considered and may be accepted. The decision of the County as to equal will be final.

15. **Supportive Documentation:**

(R042208)

In addition to specifications stated herein, all equipment/material/products/services shall meet or exceed current standards of the industry. All technical tolerances, ratings, power outputs or any technically specified criteria contained within these specifications are considered to be within the current state of the art and are currently being met by commercially available equipment/material/products/services. The fact that a manufacturer chooses not to produce equipment/material/products to meet these specifications shall not be considered sufficient cause to adjourn these specifications as restrictive. Bidder shall offer the equipment/material/products/services which comes closest to meeting these specifications. **Where deviation(s) from the specifications contained herein is necessary, the bidder shall note such deviation(s). Bidder shall include supportive documentation that clearly indicates the equipment/material/products/services they bid is equivalent to that specified herein. Failure to detail all such deviations will comprise sufficient grounds for rejection of the entire bid.**

16. **Protection from Claim Against “Or Equal”:**

(R042208)

In the event of any claim concerning or relating to the issue of “equal or better” or “equal”, the awardee agrees to hold the County of Steuben free and harmless from any and all claims for loss or damage arising out of this transaction for any reason whatsoever. The County is to be free and harmless for any and all legal fees and court costs.

17. **Addendum/Addenda:**

(R041811)

- a. If an addendum has been issued prior to the County’s receipt of bids; Steuben County shall attempt to notify potential bidders known to have received the bid documents and whose contact information is on file with the County. Steuben County does not ensure the potential bidder’s receipt of addendum. It shall be the responsibility of each bidder, prior to submitting its bid, to contact the Director of Purchasing (607) 664-2484, to determine if an addendum has been issued.
- b. Addendum shall be available for review and/or copy at the Purchasing Department, Room No. 217 of the Steuben County Office Building located in Bath, New York.
- c. It is a requirement that the bidder sign, date, and include the addendum with its bid submittal. Failure to do so may result in rejection of bid.

18. **Multiple/Alternate Bid Submittal(s):**

(R042208)

For those bidders intending to submit multiple/alternate bids in response to this bid solicitation; the bidder is required and shall submit a completed bid documents packet for each bid submitted. **Note:** However, if there is a bid surety requirement, one (1) bid surety instrument, written for the highest required amount, shall suffice.

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19. **Submittal of Bid(s):**

(R042808)

- a. For each bid it submits, **the bidder shall submit two (2) sets of its bid**; including all required documents (e.g. signed clauses, statements, forms, bonds, insurance, manufacturer's specifications, etc.)
 - i. One (1) set shall be stamped (or otherwise indicated) as being the "**ORIGINAL**."
 - ii. One (1) set shall be stamped (or otherwise indicated) as being the "**DUPLICATE**" or "**COPY**."
 - iii. Information presented in the "**ORIGINAL**" set of the bid submittal shall prevail.
- b. **Requirements for Addressing the Bid Submittal Envelope :**
 - i. The bid shall be submitted in a sealed opaque envelope marked on the outside with: the bidder's name and address and the designation: "**Sealed Bid – Cleaning, Washing and Sealing of Steuben County Bridges.**"
 - ii. The envelope shall be addressed to Andrew G. Morse, Director of Purchasing, Steuben County Office Building, 3 East Pulteney Square, Bath, New York 14810.
- c. Bids shall be received at the Purchasing Department, Room #217 of the Steuben County Office Building, until 1:30 P.M. local time on **Thursday, February 21, 2019**, at which time bids shall be opened and read publicly.
- d. Facsimile transmitted bids are not acceptable and shall be rejected.
- e. Security procedures are in effect at the Steuben County Office Building. Interested parties, especially respondents who intend to hand deliver bids and/or conduct business with the Steuben County Purchasing Department should allow sufficient time for any delay which may arise as a result of security procedures. To be considered "delivered on time," a bid submittal must be received at the Purchasing Department by the appointed hour.

20. **Late Bids:**

(R042208)

Bidders shall bear sole responsibility for the delivery of their bid in a timely manner. Reliance upon the U.S. Postal Service or other carriers is at the bidder's risk. Late bids shall not be considered and shall be returned unopened.

21. **Right of County to Seek Clarification, Accept or Reject Bid(s), etc.:**

(R042208)

- a. Steuben County reserves as its right, the right to require clarification from bidders for the purpose of assuring a full understanding of the bidder's responsiveness to the solicitation requirements.
- b. Steuben County reserves as its right; the right to accept or reject any and all bids (or separable portions thereof), the right to waive irregularities and technicalities, and the right to request resubmittal of bids (re-bid).

22. **Civil Rights:**

(R042208)

The County of Steuben, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and New York State Labor Law; Article 8 - Public Work, Section 220e hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract awarded as a result of this bid solicitation will be awarded without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex or natural origin.

23. **Award of Bid:**

(R042208)

For the purposes of this bid and subsequent award(s), **it is intended that award(s) be made to the lowest "Total Project Price Bid" for either the "Base Bid", Bid Section #3 noted on Bid Page 12 or the**

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“Alternate Bid” , Bid Section #4 noted on Bid Page 12, not both; the sum total of all applicable “*In Toto Price Bid per Specific Bridge*” line items.

- a. Award(s) shall only be made to bids submitted by qualified, responsive, and responsible bidders who sufficiently meet the terms, conditions, and specifications stated herein. **However**, under all circumstances and all statements to the contrary notwithstanding, Steuben County reserves as its right, the right to determine award(s)/awardee(s) in accordance with the best interest of Steuben County.
- b. Award of bid is not made at the bid opening. All bids are subject to final review and acceptance by the appropriate committee(s) of the Steuben County Legislature before any award may be made. Receipt of bids by the County shall not be construed as authority to bind the County.

24. **Executory Clause:**

(R041811)

Steuben County shall have no liability under any contract or contracts to any awardee or to anyone else beyond funds appropriated and available for the purposes of this bid document and resultant contract(s).

25. **Assignability:**

(R042208)

The awardee shall not assign, transfer, convey, sub-contract, sublet or otherwise dispose of all or portions of the contract (and/or work to be performed as a result of the contract) or its right, title or interest therein, or its power to execute such contract, or its responsibility therein to any other person, company or corporation, without the prior written consent of the Commissioner of Public Works and the Steuben County Public Works Committee.

26. **Authorized Purchase(s):**

(R042208)

The County’s assumption of responsibility for any and all purchases made on its behalf is in the form of a Purchase Order which is numbered, dated, complete, and bears the signature of the Director of Purchasing or other official; as designated by the Steuben County Legislature. Steuben County shall not be responsible for unauthorized purchases.

27. **Awardee’s Failure to Comply:**

(R042208)

The awardee’s failure to perform in compliance with the bid award shall result in a withholding of payment. The payment shall be withheld until such time as the awardee fulfills its responsibilities. Compliance shall be determined by and to the satisfaction of Steuben County. Such action would not necessarily preclude further initiatives on the part of Steuben County to protect and preserve its interests.

28. **Sufficient Inventory, Equipment, and Staff:**

(R042208)

Awardee is required to have sufficient inventory, equipment and staff available and/or have guaranteed access to sufficient inventory, equipment and staff to fulfill its responsibility as a result of receiving the bid award.

Failure of the awardee to fulfill its responsibility shall be sufficient cause for and entitle Steuben County to:

- a. Damages
and/or
- b. Purchase the contracted product(s)/service(s) on the open market; with any increase in cost(s) to Steuben County being charged to the awardee. Credit shall not be issued to the awardee where open market cost(s) to the County are less than the cost(s) contracted with the awardee.

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29. **Cancellation of Contract:**

(R042208)

Steuben County reserves, as its right, the right to cancel the contract(s) resulting from an award of this bid solicitation at any time during the contract period, without penalty to Steuben County and without stated reason, by delivering a written ten (10) day notice of intent to the awardee(s) or its representative(s). Said notification mailed to the awardee or its representative via the US Postal Service; First Class Mail shall be considered sufficient and delivered.

30. **Standard(s):**

(R070208)

It shall be understood by all parties that;

- a. Where in this bid document, compliance with a certain standard (or standards) is required, the awardee shall be required to comply with said standard(s) in its most recent revised form; i.e. the most current revision. The term “standard(s)” shall include, but is not limited to, all laws, mandates, regulations, etc. established by government bodies, as well as established industry and professional standards.

- b. Regardless of whether or not standards* are specified herein, it shall be deemed a requirement that all awardees adhere to the most current Government, Industry and Professional standards; regardless of whether those standards are established via dictum or “common practice”.

31. **Interchangeable Terminology:**

(R042208)

For the purpose(s) of this bid solicitation, the following terms are used interchangeably:

- a. Steuben County, County and Owner.

1. The entirety of this project shall be performed in accordance with these bid specifications and NYSDOT Standard Specifications; dated September 1, 2015 with addenda.
2. The contractor's responsibilities shall include, but is not limited to, the following pages of instructions/requirements for Item 641.3100nn16 – Maintenance Cleaning and Washing of Bridges and for Item 559.17960008 – Protective Sealing of Structural Concrete for Existing Bridge Decks. **Note:** Abrasive blasting **shall not** be allowed.

Note: Items numbers are not serialized based upon number of spans. For bridge length information, reference the “**Bridge Identification and Project Requirement(s) Table**”, specified in this bid document.
3. The contractor shall bear sole responsibility to furnish all of the following: labor, materials, equipment, mobilization, traffic control, insurance(s), permit(s), and all other ancillary items necessary to complete the project to the satisfaction of the Commissioner or his designee. The bidder shall include all costs associated with this clause in its “*In Toto Price Bid per Specific Bridge*”/“*In Toto Price Bid per Unit*”.
4. **The Contractor will be allowed to apply for dispensation from the restrictions of the NYS Labor Law in order to employ workers for no more than (5) 10 hour days in any calendar week on this project.**

ITEM 641.3100nn 16 - MAINTENANCE CLEANING AND WASHING OF BRIDGES Attachment # 1

1. DESCRIPTION

1.01 General. This work shall consist of cleaning bridges by collecting and properly disposing of trash and debris from the bridge, power washing the deck and approaches, and pressure washing all other exposed concrete and steel bridge surfaces, and cleaning the drainage system and other drainage ways as described herein.

1.02 Scope. The cleaning and washing of bridges is divided into various pay items based on the type of bridge and the condition of the paint as follows:

Maintenance Cleaning and Washing of Bridges - General specification for washing concrete bridges, or steel bridges with intact lead based paint.

Maintenance Cleaning and Washing of Bridges, No Lead Based Paint - Specification for washing painted steel bridges which do not have lead based paint present.

Maintenance Cleaning and Washing of Weathering Steel Bridges - Specification for washing unpainted, controlled oxidizing (weathering) steel bridges. Flakes and delaminations shall be washed off metal surfaces with a water pressure of **4,000 psi minimum** with the wand held **one foot or less** from the steel surface and moved parallel to the surface. Any dislodged material resting on the top of girder flanges shall be washed clean.

1.03 Definitions.

Loose paint chips - paint chips that are no longer adhered to bridge surface.

Flaking paint chips - paint chips that are still partially adhered to bridge surface.

Patina - Iron oxide coating that forms on weathering steel over time under proper environmental conditions. Dark chocolate or purple when properly formed with a tightly adhered texture. Capable of withstanding hammering or vigorous wire brushing.

Loose flakes - Coarse flakes of rust that do not tightly adhere to the weathering steel surface. Easily dislodged by a wire brushing. Early indication of a non-forming patina.

Delaminations - Larger sheets of rust that are separating from the weathering steel base metal. More severe indication of a non-forming patina.

Trash and debris - Including but not limited to sand, soil, cinders, silt, dirt, mud, salt, glass, paper, rubber, metal, wood, loose paint chips and loose pieces of concrete and asphalt and rock or stones.

Protected Migratory Birds - Includes all waterfowl, herons, hawks, owls, eagles and songbirds. Excludes rock doves (pigeons), house sparrows, European starlings and monk parakeets.

2. MATERIALS

Cleaning, Washing AND Sealing of Steuben County Bridges

Water for pressure washing shall be clean, fresh water. Detergents or other agents shall not be used.

3. CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

3.01 General. The Contractor shall provide the Engineer with a bridge by bridge schedule of the work and a work plan including work zone traffic control procedures, equipment proposed for use, identification of water source(s) that will be used, and identification of the disposal facility(s) that will be used.

Unless otherwise indicated below or in the contract documents, **all** bridge surfaces shall be cleaned, including but not limited to bridge decks, sidewalks, curbs, approach slabs and shoulders, wing walls, back walls, bridge seats, bridge railings, parapets, bridge bearings, piers and pier caps, columns, drainage features, structural steel, light standards, signs, concrete paving block, concrete beams and other surfaces. Limited paved drainage ways and gutters off-structure shall also be cleaned of debris that if permitted to remain would cast runoff back onto the structure or into its drainage ways including those that may exist underneath the structure. The extent of such removal shall be less than 100 feet but it is intended that they be only the minimum necessary to ensure that runoff is not cast back onto the structure being cleaned or its drainage ways.

Block paving and paved surfaces other than asphalt paving between adjacent or parallel bridges shall also be cleaned if indicated in the contract documents. Such cleaning shall be limited to narrow areas less than 25 feet in width.

3.02 Environmental Protection.

3.02 A. Waste. The provisions of §107-10 Managing Surplus Material & Waste shall apply to the collection, storage, transport and disposal of waste generated by this work. All sand, dirt, cinders, and other trash and debris collected from the bridge shall be disposed of at a suitable off-site disposal facility.

3.02 B. Water. The contractor may either withdraw water from local on-site sources or use water from a municipal source for bridge washing. If water is to be drawn from a local on-site water source, to protect aquatic life, there may not be any loss of water elevation at the site of withdrawal or immediately downstream of the site. To further protect aquatic life, water withdrawal shall be accomplished with use of a screened hose, with a screen size not to exceed ¼"square. To prevent the unintentional spread of invasive species such as zebra mussels, wash water withdrawn from a local on-site water source may not be transported to be used at another bridge site in a different watershed. If water is withdrawn from an onsite source, cleaning of equipment will be conducted prior to leaving that watershed. All small equipment (pumps, hoses, barriers, silt fences, floating booms, cofferdams, shovels, rakes, jumping jacks, plate tampers, boots, buckets, industrial vacuums etc.) and large equipment (backhoes, excavators, trucks, tankers, rollers, trailers, etc.) that comes into direct contact with water withdrawn from a local on-site water source must be cleaned (internally and externally) by soaking, dipping in, or scrubbing with a chlorine solution, and/or hot water or steam cleaned and allowed to dry before the next use. The provisions of § 107-12 Water Quality Protection shall apply when discharging wash water near an original body of water. Otherwise, wash water will be collected in suitable containers and disinfected prior to final disposal.

3.02 C. Birds. All nests of protected migratory birds on bridges should be presumed to be active and occupied between April 15 and August 15. The areas within 3 feet laterally of the nest should not be cleaned or washed, pressure washing should start at the 3 feet line and progress away from the nest.

Before April 15 and after August 15 nests of protected migratory birds on bridges will most likely be inactive and unoccupied. If confirmed to be unoccupied, the nests should be removed as part of the cleaning operation.

Cleaning, Washing AND Sealing of Steuben County Bridges

Nests of unprotected species should be removed as part of the cleaning operations. However, pigeons should be treated as humanely as possible, in socially and environmentally sensitive situations removal of young from the nest for raising by a wildlife rehabilitator should be considered.

- 3.02 Schedule.** All structures or bridge drainage systems over water courses shall be washed during the periods indicated in the Contract Documents. The following shall apply: Washing shall occur only when adequate flow in the stream exists to dilute possible contaminants.
- Operations shall be sequenced so as to clean structures over small bodies of water or small streams in the spring of the year when flows are greatest.
 - Bridges over trout spawning streams, categorized by DEC as Ct or Ct(s), or located at DEC yearling trout stocking sites shall be washed during time periods acceptable to the appropriate regional DEC office.
 - Washing, whether during a scheduled period or not, shall be stopped if stream flow drops below normal.
- 3.03 Work Zone Traffic Control.** Work zone traffic control shall be in accordance with MUTCD, contract documents, and §619 of the Standard Specifications. High pressure spray and high volume drainage of wash water shall be controlled so as to not present a hazard to traffic or to cause erosion of adjacent ground or drainage ways. Under no circumstances shall high pressure spray or high volume drainage of wash water be discharged directly into active traffic lanes.

3.04 Preparation. Prior to any other cleaning work, confirm that the bridge drainage system is not blocked by un-removable debris by rodding with a sewer rod or similar tool. A blocked drainage system is considered to be one from which debris cannot be removed using the means specified below in Section 3.05 below. If the Engineer has been notified, and concurs that the drainage system is blocked prior to performing other cleaning work, then clearing, dismantling and reinstalling, if required, of the drainage system, will be extra work, and the Contractor will be paid according to §1.09-05. If the Contractor does not inspect the bridge drainage system and notify the Engineer prior to beginning work, any blocked drains will be considered to be the result of the Contractor's operations, and all clearing and cleaning of the drainage system shall be done as part of the work of this specification.

All loose trash and debris shall be collected by sweeping, shoveling, vacuuming and other suitable methods. Equipment for collecting trash and other debris from bridge decks shall be determined by the Contractor, subject to the approval of the Engineer, and will normally consist of, but not be limited to, industrial vacuums, brushes, brooms, and shovels. Plastic shovels shall be used when other shovels are damaging coated surfaces. The contractor shall not cause or allow trash and/or debris from the bridge to be deposited into a wetland, stream, other water body, bridge drainage system, or active traffic lanes during the cleaning of the bridge.

3.05 Washing. When trash and debris collection from the bridge is complete, the bridge deck and approaches shall be power washed with clean fresh water as directed by the Engineer. All other bridge surfaces, including the underside of the bridge, shall be pressure washed with clean, fresh water. The washing shall be adequate to remove all visible dirt, salt, animal waste and similar debris.

The equipment for pressure washing shall be operated at pressures between **1750 and 2000 psi** with the exception of what is stated in Maintenance, Cleaning & Washing of weathering steel bridges above, and with a minimum flow rate of **3.5 gal/minute** provided that these pressures do not damage the paint or other coatings on the bridge or undercut the grout or harm the masonry plates beneath the bearings. If these pressures and flow rates cause such damage, then the Contractor shall reduce either or both to a level satisfactory to the Engineer. The pressure washer shall be operated at a distance of **one foot** from the surface. When washing stream and wetland bridges, the quantity of flow rate of the water used shall be the minimum necessary, as approved by the Engineer, to clean foreign materials from the surfaces where they are encountered.

The equipment for power washing the bridge deck and approaches will be a centrifugal water pump or comparable pump capable of delivery 100 gal/minute minimum unrestrained flow coupled to a one and one-half inch (1-1/2") hose.

Power and Pressure washing shall not be allowed when ambient temperatures are less than 40°F or when ambient temperatures are expected to drop below 40°F before the bridge is dry. The Engineer shall be the sole determiner as to when temperatures lower than 40°F are likely to occur.

Scuppers, troughs, and downspouts to the first cleanout above ground level or to their outlet if above ground shall be cleaned by using high pressure water, vacuum, or other techniques satisfactory to the Engineer. Chemical cleaning compounds shall not be used during flushing operations, unless their use has been approved by the D.E.C. and clearance has been given by the County for their use.

Debris from the cleaning operations shall not be deposited in, or around the structure, highway roadway slopes, drainage systems or streams. It shall be disposed of at a suitable off-site disposal facility.

Cleaned scuppers, downspouts and troughs shall allow the unimpeded flow of water. After cleaning has been completed the flow characteristics of the cleaned system will be evaluated by the Engineer. If flow is still impeded because of the presence of dirt or other removable matter or objects in the system, the Engineer will direct the Contractor to reclean the system, including dismantling and reinstalling, if required, at no additional cost to the County. Any damage to the system or structure that occurs during cleaning operations shall be repaired by the Contractor to the satisfaction of the Engineer at no additional expense to the County.

When concrete paving block is cleaned and washed, the removal of weeds between the blocks will not be required under this item.

Work shall be conducted in such a manner so as not to damage or remove existing epoxy protective coatings or any other protective coating on the bridge. Any damage to the structure being worked on or to surrounding structures and property shall be repaired by the Contractor at no cost to the County.

After all trash and debris have been collected, the drainage system cleaned, and washing completed, the bridge will be inspected by the Engineer. The cleaned bridge surfaces shall be free of trash and debris as described under Construction Details and the drainage system free running except those systems the Engineer agrees were damaged prior to any cleaning work on the bridge.

ITEM 559.17960008 - PROTECTIVE SEALING OF STRUCTURAL CONCRETE FOR EXISTING BRIDGE DECKS (NO ABRASIVE BLASTING ALLOWED)

Attachment # 2

DESCRIPTION:

Under this work the Contractor shall furnish and apply, in accordance with this specification, a protective sealer to concrete surfaces, at locations indicated on the plans or proposal booklet or where directed by the Engineer.

MATERIALS:

The protective sealer shall be a non-water based sealer appearing on the Department's Approved List for Section 717-03- Penetrating Type Protective Sealers.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:

- A. General. The Contractor shall provide the Engineer with the sealer Manufacturer's written instructions for application and use, at least five (5) working days before the start of work. Only one (1) brand and specific type of sealer will be allowed for use on each individual deck.
- B. Surface Preparation.
1. Existing Concrete. Concrete surfaces to be sealed shall be thoroughly cleaned by pressurized water. The surface shall be allowed to air dry for a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours and then be vacuum cleaned to remove loose particles immediately before the sealer is applied. If the concrete is subjected to rain or moisture from other project operations, the surface shall be allowed to air dry for a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours before the sealer is applied. In the early A.M. the Engineer may direct a waiting period for drying by the sun on the surfaces to be sealed. If the surfaces are not sealed within seven (7) calendar days after the pressure wash the Engineer, due to debris, may direct a rewashing of the total or partial surface to be sealed at the Contractors expense.
 2. Care shall be taken while cleaning that all dirt is removed with minimal exposure of coarse aggregate. After cleaning, no laitance, standing water, dirt or other foreign particles shall be present which may prevent penetration or adhesion of the sealer. All surface preparation work shall be completed and approved by the Engineer, before sealer application can commence.
- C. Weather Limitations. Sealer materials shall not be applied during wet weather conditions or, if in the opinion of the Engineer, adverse weather conditions are anticipated within six (6) hours of the completion of sealer application. Ambient and surface temperatures shall be a minimum of 50° F during application and until the sealed concrete is dry to the touch. Application by spray methods will not be permitted during windy conditions, if in the opinion of the Engineer unsatisfactory results will be obtained.
- D. Sealer Application.
- 1) The sealer shall be used as supplied by the manufacturer without the use of any thinning alterations, or additives unless specifically required in the manufacturer's instructions. Thorough mixing of the sealer before and during its use shall be accomplished as recommended by the manufacturer. The Engineer will view any mixing of all materials. The equipment for all sealing operations will be clean of foreign materials and in good working order for the application rate, it will be approved by the Engineer. If in the opinion of the Engineer the application equipment

becomes nonfunctional it will be rejected.

- 2) When using the penetration sealer, the contractor will observe the number of coats with the application rate using the application equipment as recommended by the manufacturer. The contractor will achieve the total coating as stated in the approved material list of the NYSDOT Materials Bureau of gallons per square foot. Care shall be exercised with each coat that running or puddling does not occur. No sealer shall be allowed to run over the sides of the bridge surface. If more than one coat is required each successive coat shall be allowed to dry according to the manufacturer's instructions, before the removal of maintenance and protection of traffic. No artificial means to accelerate the drying of the sealer shall be allowed.

- 3) On sloping and vertical concrete surfaces, sealer application shall progress from bottom to top. Care shall be taken to ensure that the entire surface of the concrete is covered and all pores filled.

- b) The County of Steuben has made a determination that the goods or services are necessary for the County to perform its functions and that, absent such an exemption, the County of Steuben would be unable to obtain the goods or services for which the bid/proposal is offered. Such determination shall be made by the County in writing and shall be a public document.
