

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING COUNTY OF STEUBEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Steuben County Legislature will hold a public hearing at the Steuben County Annex Building, 2nd Floor Conference Room, 20 East Morris Street in the Village of Bath, New York on the 22nd day of June 2020, at 10:00 a.m. to discuss the possible submission of one or more Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications for the 2020 program year.

Given the ongoing COVID-19 public health crises and related Executive Orders issued by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, the County will not be able to accommodate any in-person public attendance or participation at this hearing. Nonetheless, and in furtherance of the CDBG program requiring interested parties be provided a reasonable opportunity to present their views with respect to the program, Steuben County will provide the public the opportunity to submit written comments to be included in the record of the public hearing. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and will make funds available to eligible local governments for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternative proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1974, as amended.
