

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
RELATIVE TO PARCELS FOR INCLUSION IN
CERTIFIED AGRICULTURAL DISTRICTS 1, 3 AND 6
DURING THE ANNUAL THIRTY-DAY REVIEW PERIOD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held by the Steuben County Legislature on the 27th day of July, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. relative to land submitted for inclusion in certified agricultural districts 1, 3 and 6 during the 2020 annual thirty-day review period; to consider the recommendations of the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board, and proposed modifications of said certified agricultural districts.

Given the ongoing COVID-19 public health crises and related Executive Orders issued by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, the County will not be able to accommodate any in-person public attendance or participation at this hearing. Nonetheless, interested parties will be provided a reasonable opportunity to present their views with respect to the proposed agricultural districts' modifications. Steuben County will provide the public the opportunity to submit written comments to be included in the record of the public hearing. It is the recommendation of the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board that the parcels submitted for inclusion in Steuben County certified agricultural districts 1, 3 and 6 during the 2020 annual thirty-day period under Article 25AA, Section 303-b of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York be included in their respective districts.
